The objectives behind awarding scholarships, prizes, and medals to students are as follows:

1. Financial Assistance:

To support meritorious students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, including SC, ST, OBC, and others, the institute may grant:

- i. Scholarships
- ii. Tuition waivers (Free Ships)
- 1.1. Recognizing exceptional academic achievements, excellence in courses, research, social service, sports, cultural activities, and counseling, the institute may award scholarships, prizes, and awards from its own funds or external governmental/non-governmental sources.
- 1.2. Encouraging graduate/postgraduate studies, the institute may provide scholarships/assistant-ships sourced from their funds or other governmental/non-governmental funds.
- 1.3. Promoting research and development, scholarships, prizes, and medals can be awarded to undergraduate and postgraduate students from institute funds or external sources.

2. Criteria for Evaluation:

- 2.1. Merit (Academic Performance):
- 2.1.1. Evaluation based on a student's Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).
- 2.1.2. The CGPA rounded off to the first decimal point is typically considered, with the possibility of considering a higher decimal in special cases. Minimum CGPA requirements might vary for different awards.

2.2. All-Round Performance:

- 2.2.1. Evaluation based on a student's collective performance in academics, research, social service, sports, cultural activities, and counseling, including leadership roles.
- 2.2.2. Special committee shall be constituted for evaluating candidates for each award of this nature with the Chairman, Director, Principal.

3.1. Financial Assistance from Institute Funds:

3.1.1. In order to financially assist to meritorious students coming from economically weaker background.

3.2. Institute Medals and Prizes:

- 1. Recognition through cash prizes and certificates for top performers in different departments (B.Tech, MBA, MCA) for outgoing batches.
- 2. Guidelines specifying forfeiture or withdrawal of awards due to misconduct or misleading information by the awardee.
- 3. Requirements for students leaving the institute prematurely to refund the scholarship amount\ received for that academic year.
- 4. Policies regarding receiving multiple scholarships from different sources and the subsequent options available to the student.
- 5. No scholarship payments beyond the examination completion month.
