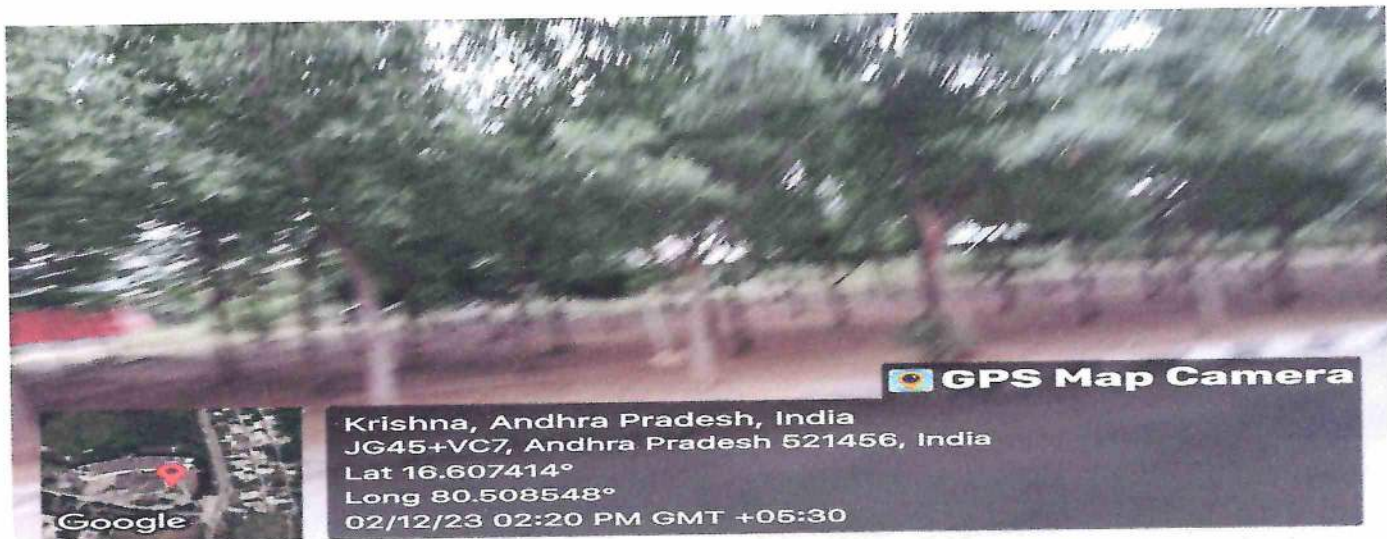

Event description	<p>On 29th March, 2023, Nimra College of Engineering and Technology, Jupudi, successfully conducted a “Clean India - Green India” campaign under the NSS unit of NCET at the adopted village Jupudi as part of the National Cleaning Week (NCW). The campaign started around at 11:30 am with a key note address about the purpose of campaign by Dr.Akbar Khan, the Principal of the college. He encouraged the participants to maintain open defecation free environs and sustainable environment practices, as well as to keep surroundings clean and hygiene by minimizing the solid waste.</p> <p>Thereafter, all the volunteers moved to the adopted village and started cleaning activities to disseminate the healthy sanitation practices. They swept away the biodegradable waste materials and disposed safely. Some of the participants collected non-biodegradable solid waste materials from either side of road and streets which littered and scattered in particularly plastic ropes, nets, wrappers, water cans, broken glasses, carry-bags and single used plastic bottles. The collected waste matters threw in to the big dustbins and transferred to recycle center within Jupudi Gram Panchayat with the help of Gram Panchayat workforce.</p> <p>Before the end of the campaign, they interacted with local people of village to spread awareness about the effects of improper disposal of non-biodegradable matters and educated them individually on how they could dispose plastic items properly that they currently had and requested them to say no to plastic in the future.</p> <p>At the end, NSS Program Officer Dr.A.Venkateswara Rao</p>
