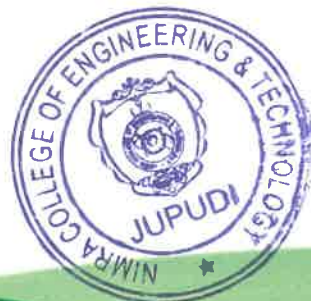

2. Once in five years while renewing the certificate the Registered Medical Practitioners should intimate his/her address to the Registrar for keeping the Registration alive.
3. All persons registered under this Act are eligible to practice modern system of medicine.
