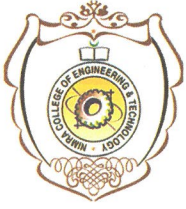

ABOUT CLUB

Substance abuse, especially involving narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor, has emerged as a major threat to society and a serious health crisis affecting the youth on college campuses and within communities across the nation.

In this connection, The NSS Unit **Nimra College of Engineering and Technology (NCET)**, Jupudi, has constituted the **ANTI-NARCOTIC DRUGS, TOBACCO, and LIQUOR PROHIBITION** Committee for the **Academic Year 2025–2026** in association with the Local Welfare Department and the Prohibition and Excise Station Committee, Bhavanipuram, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh 520012.

The committee aims to create awareness among students regarding the harmful effects of substance abuse and to promote a healthy, drug-free academic environment within the institution and the community.

As per the guidelines of the **All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)**, the Committee comprises students, faculty members, and officials from the Prohibition and Excise Station Committee, with the sole objective of effectively preventing illicit activities related to narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor.

The Committee is entrusted with the responsibility of ensuring a narcotic drugs-, tobacco-, and liquor-free campus and community by enforcing a complete ban on the possession, consumption, or use of **DRUGS, TOBACCO, and LIQUOR** by students both within and outside the college campus. The Committee also strives to create awareness among the local community residing in the surrounding areas of the college and to promote a healthy, safe, and disciplined environment for all.



The duties of the Anti-Narcotic Drugs, Tobacco, and Liquor Prohibition Committee include organizing various rallies, awareness programs, counseling sessions, camps, and drives under the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit with the support and cooperation of Welfare Officers, members of the Prohibition and Excise Station Committee, Special Enforcement Bureau (SEB) officials, local administrative authorities, and other government-authorized agencies or organizations of the State and Central Government of India.

The Committee also aims to educate students and the local community about the harmful effects of narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor, and to promote a healthy, disciplined, and drug-free environment within the campus and surrounding community.

Objective and Functions

OBJECTIVE

1. To make the campus and surrounding community premises free from liquor, tobacco, and narcotic drugs.
2. To safeguard the well-being and health of students and community members.
3. To promote community health and empower young people to make informed and responsible choices regarding their lifestyle and well-being.

FUNCTIONS

1. To monitor and check any possible infiltration of narcotic drugs, tobacco, or liquor into the college campus.
2. To identify the use of narcotic drugs, tobacco, or liquor among students and community members, create awareness, and provide appropriate counseling and guidance.
3. To develop and implement various preventive measures and monitoring mechanisms to curb narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor-related illicit activities.
4. To educate students and the community about the consequences, risk factors, health hazards, and social crisis caused by the consumption of narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor.
5. To extend awareness among students and the community regarding the negative impacts of narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor consumption on personal life, family relationships, education, and social well-being.



6. To encourage students to actively participate in anti-narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor prohibition activities and motivate them to voluntarily raise their voice against substance abuse within the campus and surrounding community through a proactive and multifaceted approach.
7. To strengthen the anti-narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor movement by organizing awareness programs, campaigns, rallies, and counseling activities in the college campus, hostels, and nearby surrounding areas with the support of authorized agencies and organizations.
8. To promote the formation of elite Anti-Narcotic Drugs, Tobacco, and Liquor awareness groups and involve social activists in educational institutions located in nearby areas.
9. To ensure strict prohibition and prevention of the sale and use of narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor and to discourage the initiation and progression of substance abuse leading to addiction.
10. To encourage peer monitoring and reporting among students and community members regarding the use of narcotic drugs, tobacco, and liquor and to inform the Anti-Narcotic Drugs, Tobacco, and Liquor Committee about any such incidents noticed.
11. To take prompt and strict action regarding any possession or use of narcotic drugs, tobacco, or liquor brought to the notice of the Committee and to report such cases to the Prohibition and Excise Station Committee, SEB officials, CID authorities, or the nearby local police authorities for necessary action.
